WHAT IS THRIFT SHOP CLOTHING MARKET?

Thrift Shop Clothing Market is a secondhand clothing market run by the team at The Greens on William. We provide stalls in a market layout where individual sellers will have fashion for women, men and children available for purchase. You can sell your secondhand or new clothing, shoes and accessories by purchasing a stall online. We provide the space, and venue and you provide the goods! The gold coin entry fee for shoppers will be donated to a local charity.



HOW CAN I BECOME A SELLER?

You can become a seller by purchasing a stall online.
All sellers MUST have purchased a stall online prior to arriving at our market. These stalls are available to purchase via links from our website and our social media platforms.



WHAT INFORMATION DO I NEED TO PROVIDE TO BE A SELLER?

All sellers MUST provide a valid contact email address that is checked frequently as this is how we contact all sellers regarding information for the day, change of dates or any other important matters. All sellers MUST supply the name of the person who will check in to the stall on the market day. Please only put one name and make sure it is the name of the person who will be at the market first.









HOW MUCH DOES IT COST AND WHAT DO I GET WITH MY STALL?

Stalls: \$33.00 + online Booking Fees. This provides you with a 2.5m x 2.5m space inside our markets.

A limited number of outdoor stalls on our veranda & beer garden will also be available.

Our markets are all undercover unless you have purchased an outside stall. Outside stalls are not refundable due to weather conditions. If you purchase an outside stall it is at your own risk due to weather.

Depending on our location, your stall will be on carpet or wooden floorboards.

PLEASE NOTE: Stall spaces come empty but you can request 1 x trestle table when booking your stall. Your stand **DOES NOT** include any racks, hangers etc. Please also note that gazebos are not permitted inside. Sellers must provide all fittings and fixtures within their stall.

Please also note the sizes of your fixtures. If your fixtures do not fit in the allocated space you will be asked to remove them.

All sellers' stalls are designated on the market day by The Greens on William team. All sellers' stalls are measured on the day by The Greens on William team.

All sellers agree that by purchasing a ticket they are acknowledging the size of their stalls.

No refunds are given because sellers were unaware of the size of stall.



CAN I SHARE A STALL SPACE?

Yes you can! Please remember however that you MUST fit exactly in this space, so you need to make sure that you can fit inside your stall comfortably if you are sharing.

CAN I PURCHASE TWO STALL SPACES AND COMBINE THEM?

Of course! If you need more space you are able to purchase two stalls and combine the spaces. If you purchase more than one stall at once we will make sure that all of these stalls are together for you on the day.

SETTING UP YOUR STALL

Sellers are given a clear space to set up their stall on hardwood floor or carpet. Sellers are permitted to bring racks, hangers, tables, chairs, mirrors, suitcases etc. to set up but MUST ensure that these items do not scratch, leave marks or damage the floor in any way at all. Items that have feet that are not covered/protected to ensure no damage are prohibited.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE PICKED UP AND CARRIED WHEN ENTERING AND EXITING THE VENUE TO PREVENT DAMAGE.

This includes bags, racks, items and stock, boxes and boxes with wheels. The only item that may be pulled across the floor is racks that have wheels that are not plastic.

All plastic containers or items with plastic wheels MUST be carried inside. The Greens on William reserves the right to terminate any stall that is deemed to be damaging the venue's property.



WHAT CAN I SELL?

Thrift Shop Clothing Market is for clothing, shoes and accessories for women, men, children and babies. These items can be brand new, worn but in good condition, handmade or vintage.

WHAT CAN I NOT SELL?

Sellers are prohibited from selling the following: used sleepwear, underwear or swimwear, makeup, home wares, food, homemade products, electrical products, animals, poisonous products, prescription medications, illegal or offensive items, firearms, ammunition, explosives, weapons or dangerous goods of any kind, cigarettes/alcohol/drugs and illegal drug-related products, cosmetics or fragrances. Sellers are also unable to sell children's toys.

The NSW Government, Office of Fair Trading, administers a range of national mandatory safety and information standards and bans for particular products supplied in the consumer marketplace, including weekend markets.

Standards apply to children's toys, nightwear, cosmetics and care labeling on clothing and textiles. Full details of these regulated consumer products can be viewed and downloaded from the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) website at http://www.productsafety.gov.au.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING BANNED ACTIVITIES

Art union or raffle tickets, the conducting of any guessing game, lucky dip, chocolate wheel, side-show, competition, or game of chance is prohibited.

Sellers may not sell anything that may leak or contain fluids, nothing that may cause damage by being dragged across floors, no items that have legal restrictions upon their sale or disposal. Sellers are not able to hang items inside off of gazebos or any other similar structure.

No gazebos or other large fixtures inside.

NO FAKE ITEMS/REPLICAS ARE TO BE SOLD AT THRIFT SHOP CLOTHING MARKET

Sellers will not be covered under public liability insurance if found to be selling any of the above items

REFUNDS DUE TO CANCELLATION ON BEHALF OF SELLERS

The Greens on William allows sellers to cancel their stall up to 10 days prior to market date. You will be refunded the full cost of your stall minus any booking fees. No refunds will be accepted after this date.



REFUNDS DUE TO CANCELLATION ON BEHALF OF THE GREENS ON WILLIAM

If the Thrift Shop Clothing Market is cancelled due to emergency, danger, weather conditions, disasters, safety, health concerns or other reasons that not in a reasonable control of The Greens on William organized (as deemed and only when announced by the Thrift Shop Clothing Market organizers) sellers will be allocated to a new date for the market, if the new date is not accessible for sellers a full refund will be given minus booking fees.

CAN I TRANSFER OR SELL MY STALL TO A FRIEND IF I CANNOT MAKE THE MARKET?

Sellers are able to transfer their stall to a friend or family member up to the market date if unable to attend the market date. Please ensure to email us at info@thegreensonwilliam.com.au with an updated name for your stall and contact email address.

The Greens on William is not responsible for selling or trying to find new stallholders past these cut off dates. If you are unable to attend and are outside of the refund/transfer period and cannot find a new seller or transfer to a friend, all fees will be forfeited. Non-attendance on the day of market is non-refundable.

The Greens on William reserves the right to terminate a stall at any given time either before or during the market if sellers: threaten any member of The Greens on William team or the general public, demonstrate lewd, disruptive or disrespectful behaviour to any member of The Greens on William team or the general public, fail to comply with market terms and conditions, commit a criminal act whilst at our market, fail to attend and set up prior to designated time of market, fail to comply with ACCC regulations and rules.



INSURANCE

The Greens on William holds current Public Liability insurance of \$20,000,000. All stalls must hold Public Liability insurance of \$10,000.00 specifying Market Stall.

SECURITY

All sellers are responsible for their own stall security, monies and stock. No responsibility is taken by The Greens on William for theft, loss or damage.



SAFETY

All sellers agree to set up their stalls in a safe and secure manner to ensure the safety of sellers, general public and The Greens on William team.

The Greens on William reserves the right to remove anything from the market that is deemed unsafe. The Greens on William is not responsible for any injury or accidents caused by sellers due to negligence to conduct themselves or their stall safely.

In the event of an accident, injury or emergency The Greens on William has a safety procedure in place to ensure the incident is handled efficiently. Sellers and the general public are required to fill in an incident report if an incident occurs.

The Greens on William has trained has a first aid kit onsite

ON THE DAY

All sellers will receive an information pack prior to our market day which will contain set up and pack down times and vital information for the day.

Please only bring along clothes that are in a good, saleable condition. No rips, tears, stains, smells, shrinkage, pulling etc. The Greens on William does not guarantee the sale of any of your items, it is up to you whether you deem an item saleable.

The Greens on William does not guarantee how much money on any given market that any seller can or will make. The Greens on William provides a space and a platform to be able to sell items, however we are not responsible for whether or not a seller has a 'good' day. There are bathrooms available at our venue to be used as change rooms and will be pointed out via signage.

Please ensure you do not pack down prior to closing of market unless there is an emergency or confirmed with a The Greens on William team member. Please ensure to take ALL rubbish with you. The Greens on William reserves the right to BAN any seller who leaves behind rubbish.

ADVERTISING

The Greens on William provides advertising in the form of signage, flyers, social media and online advertising and wherever possible media. Sellers are required to advertise their stalls on platforms such as Facebook & Instagram.

The Thrift Shop Clothing Market is a MARKET EVENT and as such, we can never guarantee the turnout of any market event. No refunds are given if a low attendance is recorded. It is the risk of having a market stall and by purchasing a sellers ticket all sellers are agreeing to this.
